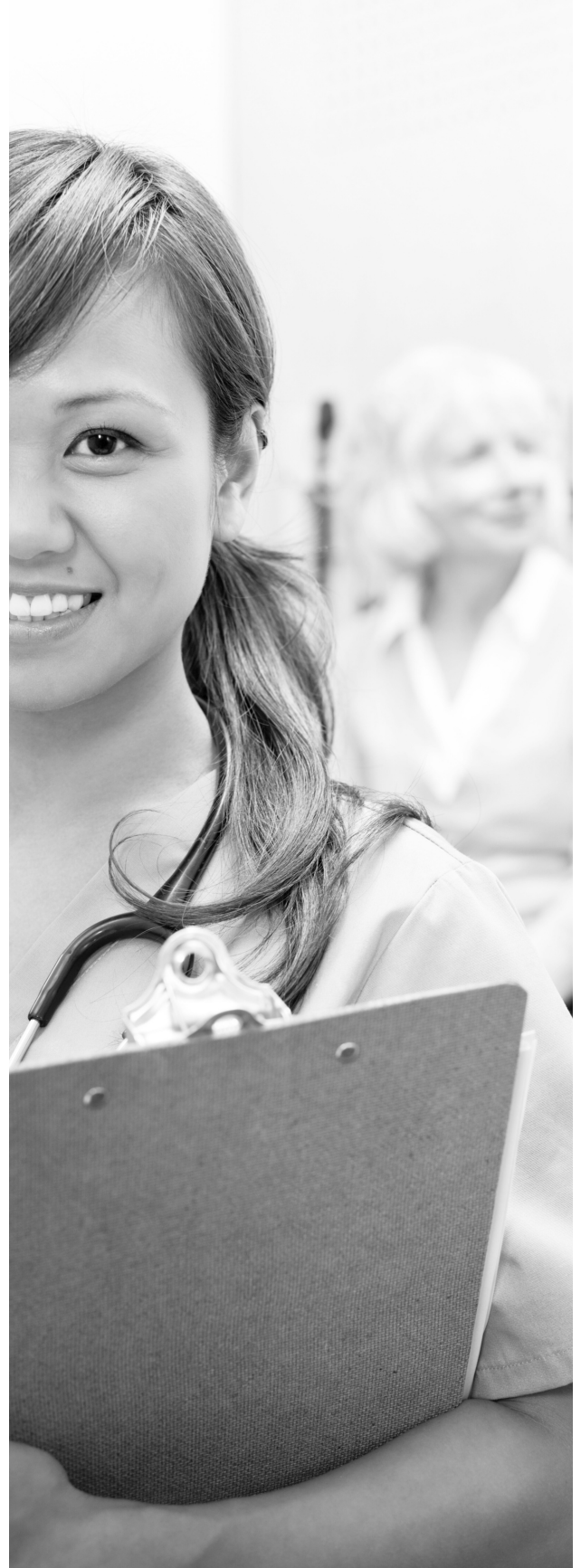
A HIGH-CALIBER CLASSROOM CURRICULUM WITH HANDS-ON, CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

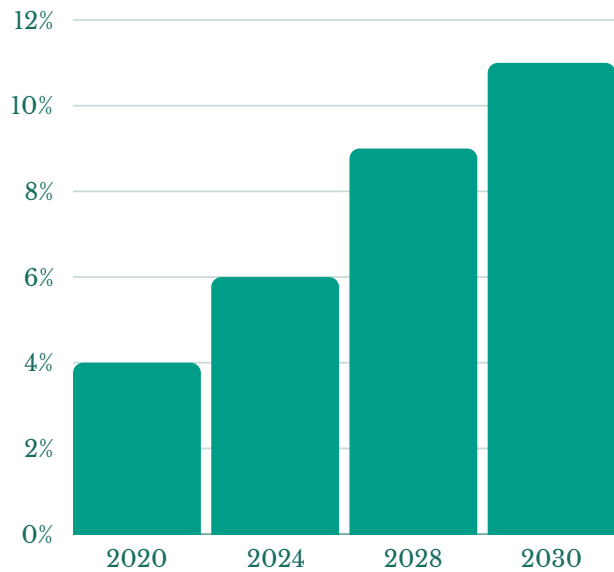
- Concurrent lecture, lab, and clinicals take place in our modern medical clinic, allowing students to learn and apply knowledge and skills in real time

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years of age or older
- High school diploma or GED
- Background check
- Proof of Hepatitis B vaccination (started or completed); proof of two-step TB skin test
- Application, including personal statement
- Literate in English / EAP Exam
- Eligible to work in the United States
- Students applying for financial aid/workforce development funding may be required to complete additional screening and career testing
